

On 25 November 2018, the residents of Bandar Seri Coalfields were treated to a unique experience with the 19th Malaysian Kennel Association (MKA) Rally-O and the 96th Obedience Trials, jointly organised by MKA and Canine SportzClub.

Taking place at the BSC Central Park, the event proved to be an enlightening Sunday for attendees, helping improve awareness on responsible pet ownership and pet health, as well as spreading information on effective training techniques.

The trainers and dogs taking part in the 96th Obedience Trials were divided into five categories; rookie, pre-novice, novice, intermediate and open. Judging for the competition was carried out by Australian dog training expert Mrs. Gloria Page. There was also a special talk on animal health by Dr. Hasnul Ismail from Heshmael's Clinic For Pets, and a talk on responsible dog ownership by Canine SportzClub trainer Justin Tien.

Capping off the event was a presentation by Search & Rescue Dogs Malaysia in which four dogs certified by the Austria-based International Rescue Organisation demonstrated techniques for searching for missing persons.

The Inaugural KLK Land Community Cyclethon

On 15 July 2018, KLK Land successfully organised its inaugural Community Cyclethon 2018 at the BSC Central Park.

After the race, participants were entertained by a variety of fun games and activities, including a selfie contest, fun fact quizzes,

The objective of the KLK Land Community Cyclethon is to introduce a healthy lifestyle through cycling in the natural setting of Bandar Seri Coalfields and its 50-acre Central Park. The event attracted close to 500 participants comprising family members and professional cyclists from the township's residents and neighbouring communities.

The Cyclethon consists of two categories; The 10KM Fun Ride which is entirely on road in the township, and the 15KM Mountain Bike Ride, of which 20% is on road in the township and 80% is off-road in KLK's nearby Tuan Mee estate.

Both rides started at the BSC Central Park with a duration of one hour. The 15KM Mountain Bike Ride was flagged off first at 8:00 a.m. by KLK Land Managing Director Dato' David Tan Thean Thye, followed by the 10KM Fun Ride, which was kicked off by KLK Land Senior General Manager Prakash Prasannan at 8:15 a.m.

Over the duration of one hour, the participants enjoyed the fresh morning breeze over the tranquil lake setting of the Central Park, as well as the thrilling and challenging terrain of the Tuan Mee estate. Some of the high points of the estate offer panoramic views over the LATAR Expressway and the mountain range beyond.

After the race, participants were entertained by a variety of fun games and activities, including a selfie contest, fun fact quizzes, food challenges, treasure hunts and buskers' performances. Families who brought their children enjoyed themselves at the inflatable playground and the Play Deck, which was newly completed at the Central Park.
